

Public Works I - Seasonal

Reports to: Public Works Supervisor Salary Range: \$12 - \$15 Hour FLSA Status: Non-Exempt

The Town of Kensington is currently accepting applications for a *seasonal employee within the Public Works Department*. **Essential Functions include**: assisting with maintenance and repair work; picking up trash; cleaning ditches; raking leaves; patching holes; and mowing and trimming grass. **Required Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities**: ability to understand and follow specific oral instructions; ability to perform heavy manual labor for extended periods of time, often under unfavorable weather conditions; and the ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with associates. **Minimum Education and Experience**: High School Graduation or equivalency; supplemented by six (6) months of experience in related manual work; or any equivalent combination of education, training, and experience. **Special Requirements:** the possession and ability to maintain a valid driver's license.

This is a seasonal position with the Dept. of Public Works that is expected to last from May 2013 through November 2013. The salary range for this position is \$12 - \$15 an hour, depending on qualifications; with a work week consisting of 35-40 hours. Benefits are not available with this position.
