pursuant to Section 708 of the Town Charter, and Section 2-205 of the Town Code.

Town Charter - Section 708 - Nominations

Persons may be nominated for elective office in the Town by filing a certificate of nomination at the office of the Board of Supervisors of Elections on or before the second Monday in May preceding the Town election. No person shall file for nomination to more than one elective Town public office or to hold more than one elective Town public office at any one time.

Town Code - Section 2-205 - Nominations

Pursuant to Section 708 of the Town Charter, persons may be nominated for elective office in the Town by filing a certificate of nomination with the office of the Board of Supervisors of Elections on or before the second Monday in May preceding any Town election. No person shall file for nomination to more than one elective Town office nor may any person hold more than one elective Town office at any one time.

And do hereby certify that I comply with either Section 503 or 403 of the Town Charter, as appropriate.

Town Charter - Section 503 - Qualifications of the Mayor

The Mayor shall have resided in the Town for at least one year immediately preceding the election and shall be qualified to be registered voter of the Town. The Mayor shall maintain permanent residence in the Town during the term of office.

Town Charter - Section 403 - Qualifications of Council Members

Council Members shall have resided in the Town for at least one year immediately preceding their election and shall be qualified to be registered voters of the Town. Council Members shall maintain permanent residence in the Town during their term of office.

In addition, I understand that if I am a non-incumbent candidate for elective office I must comply with provisions of the Article 3, entitled "Public Ethics" particularly Section 2-308, of the Town Code:

Town Code - Section 2-308 - Financial Disclosure

(c) Non-incumbent candidates for elective offices and proposed appointees for any boards or commissions enumerated in Section 2-301 of this Article shall file statements consistent with the requirements of this Section at the time they file their certificates of candidacy or upon their nominations for appointment from the most recent January to the date of filing.
