

RESOLUTION No. R-10-2019

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF KENSINGTON, MARYLAND, AUTHORIZING THE TOWN MANAGER TO INSTALL “TWO HOUR, 7:30 AM – 5:30 PM, M-F”, SIGNS ALONG THE NORTHEAST SIDE OF THE 10300 BLOCK OF KENSINGTON PARKWAY, ADJACENT TO THE POSTOFFICE, IN LIEU OF THE EXISTING 1 HOUR PARKING SIGNS

Whereas, Chapter IV, “Traffic and Vehicles”, Section 4-103, “Traffic and Parking Control Devices” of the Town Code states:


The Council may, by resolution, have erected “stop,” “no parking,” “speed limit,” “one way,” “yield,” “no U-turn,” “no-thru traffic,” “no right turn,” and “do not enter” signs and other traffic control and parking restriction devices to control, regulate, warn, or guide traffic or limit parking on streets, other public ways, or other areas in the Town of Kensington; and

Whereas, the Town’s Traffic Committee has recommended certain traffic control changes to the Mayor and Town Council, to include:

Install “Two Hour, 7:30 AM-5:30 PM, M-F, signs along the NORTHEAST side of the 10300 block of Kensington Parkway, adjacent to the Post Office, in lieu of existing 1 hour parking signs.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved that the Town Manager is hereby authorized to implement the aforementioned traffic controls.
