2. Next year discussion

- Take time to reflect over the summer which projects we will want to take forward next year (see ppt accompanying these notes for a summary of other actions we've identified in our years 2-3), which we will decide on during our September meeting.
- Consider who we might want to recruit to support the sub-projects and which parts of our community are not well represented that we want to make sure are included next year. **Ann and Nate to check with Council to see if non-ToK resident neighbors can participate in targeted projects.**
- Have a table at Labor Day parade and festival to promote SK and recruit new participants. **Need someone to volunteer to lead in organizing our table over the summer.**
- Stay on the lookout for grant opportunities for the various actions, and we will consider whether to have a separate workstream on finance opportunities when we prioritize during our September meeting.
