

May 23, 2024, Town Council Special Meeting Summary (held by Zoom Video Conferencing)

- Adopted **Resolution No. R-10-2024** – A Resolution of the Mayor and Town Council declaring the first Friday in June to be National Gun Violence Awareness Day in the Town of Kensington to honor and remember all victims and survivors of gun violence and to declare that we as a Country must do more to reduce gun violence.
- Adopted **Resolution No. R-11-2024** - A Resolution of the Mayor and Council of the Town of Kensington Authorizing an Addendum to the Contract Agreement with Brudis & Associates, Inc. (Resolution No. R-02-2024), to provide Engineering and Support Services for a Storm Drain Study within the area of the 10700 and 10800 blocks of St. Paul Street in the amount of \$23,550.00.
 - This is an addendum to the original contract (Resolution No. R-02-2024), in which the scope of the Drainage Study has expanded following the initial review of the watershed.

Ordinances, Resolutions, and Regulations

Resolution No. R-11-2024 - A Resolution of the Mayor and Council of the Town of Kensington Authorizing an Addendum to the Contract Agreement with Brudis & Associates, Inc. (Resolution No. R-02-2024), to provide Engineering and Support Services for a Storm Drain Study within the area of the 10700 and 10800 blocks of St. Paul Street in the amount of \$23,550.00. This is an addendum to the original contract (Resolution No. R-02-2024), in which the scope of the Drainage Study has expanded following the initial review of the watershed was presented. Town Manager Hoffman stated that following the initial review of the watershed area, it was determined that the storm drain inlets would need to be placed along the east side of St. Paul Street in order to avoid relocating an existing Washington Gas main line, and to capture additional runoff from Kensington Heights Park. An additional survey of the existing storm drain inlets and pipe inverts will be necessary, which will be presented in a separate resolution.

Council Actions

Council Member Lichter moved to adopt Resolution No. R-10-2024 declaring the first Friday in June to be National Gun Violence Awareness Day in the Town of Kensington. The motion passed unanimously.

Council Member Crimmins moved to adopt Resolution No. R-11-2024.
