Kensington WALKtober is an annual walking tour through the community. The event celebrates and highlights recent and planned walkability and bikeability improvements made by the City. A primary goal of WALKtober is to applaud our walkable footprint and bring more people into our downtown to discover the variety of businesses and services Kensington has to offer.

When and Where is WALKtober 2024?

WALKtober is scheduled for Saturday, October 19th (rain date is Sunday, October 20th). The predetermined route of approximately 1 hour will be announced in September.

Why Should My Business Participate?

WALKtober offers businesses a unique opportunity to support the community, raise your profile and attract new customers. **There is no cost to you to participate in WALKtober.** Businesses are able to "endorse" our unique walkable/bikeable community and get broad exposure through general promotions and direct purchasing from those joining the walking tour (typically 20-30 walkers).

How Does my Business Participate?

- Register to participate either by clicking on the link below or contacting Tyler by August 15th.
- Promote the event by posting an event flyer in your window and handing out event post-cards.
- Agree to honor \$10 coupons that event participants will be given to redeem at the participating stores. Coupons can be used only once and at one location only; we will set an expiration date for coupon use. Business owners who receive any WALKtober coupons provide the \$10 discount to the customer. Businesses then return the redeemed coupons to the Town Hall for 100% reimbursement.

Event Promotion

The event will be announced at the Labor Day Parade. It will be supported through online advertising, word -of-mouth and participating businesses will be provided materials to share with customers.
