

**Resolution No. R-21-2025**  
Adopted: November 18, 2025

A Resolution of the Mayor and Town Council of Kensington Authorizing the Town Manager to accept the proposal from Shannon-Baum Signs for the refabrication of the existing Antique Row sign at the intersection of Connecticut and Howard Avenues.

**Whereas**, pursuant to Chapter II, "Government and Administration", Article 4, "Purchasing and Contracts", Subsection 2-404, "Awarding of Bids", the Mayor and Council may bypass any or all bid procedure steps, by an extra-majority vote of the Town Council, and authorize the Town Manager to directly negotiate with any supplier if it is in the Town's best interest to do so; and

**Whereas**, the Town requested a proposal from Shannon-Baum Signs to repair and fabricate the existing Antique Row sign along Howard Avenue; and

**Whereas**, Shannon-Baum Signs provided a proposal, detailed within Exhibit A, for a total sum of \$15,055.87; and

**Whereas**, Exhibit A provides a scope of work for the proposed services; and


**Whereas**, the Town Manager is recommending that the Mayor and Council accept the proposal from Shannon-Baum Signs for an amount not to exceed \$18,000.00.


